Georgia Tech Resources

STAR Services - provides temporary student assistance such as clothing, food insecurities, crisis housing, and financial assistance

Student Emergency Fund - assists qualifying students with up to \$500 for the academic year

Office of the Provost - the Assistant Vice Provost for Advocacy and Conflict Resolution interprets and enforces policies and rules, as well as the grievances, complaints, and inquiries by Tech students

Equity & Compliance Programs - processes all informal and formal Title IX complaints relating to gender and sex based discrimination.

Name Change on Campus Records - students are able to change their preferred name to be reflected in Tech databases
